Now Know Ye,that the United states of America,in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the aforesaid act,have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John H.Rankin and to his heirs,#### the lands last above described:To have and to hold thesame,together with all the rights,privileges,immunities and appurtenances of whatever n nature thereunto belonging,unto the said John H.Rankin and to his heirs and assigns forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted,a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof I,Theodore Roosevelt,President of the United States of America,have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the fourth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty eights.
