This Indenture Witnesseth that Mary G. Smith and H.G. Smith, wife and husband, parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations to them in hand paid by E.H. Elliott, party of the second part, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described premises, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit:

The Southeast quarter of Section two (2), Township One (1) North of Range five East of Willamette Meridian. Together with all our right, title and interest in and to that certain indenture made and entered into the 8th day of May 1908, by and between Mary G. Smith, one of the grantors above named, and E.J. Blazier, wherein and whereby the said Mary G. Smith leased, demised and let unto the said J.E. Blazier, his heirs and assigns a strip of land sufficiently wide to construct a single track standard gauge logging railway over and through said above described premises; said lease to run for a period of fifteen years for the consideration of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each year of said term. To have and to hold the said premises, with all their appurtenances unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Mary G. Smith and H.G.
