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United States to Heirs of Margaret Thomas.

To all to whome these presents shall come, Greeting:

Certificate No. 8044

Whereas the heirs of Margaret Thomas has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, whereby it appears that lawful payment has been made by the said Heirs of Margaret Thomas, according to the provisions of Congress of the 24th day of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the South half of the Northeast quarter of Section eight and the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section nine in Township two North of Range seven east of Willamette Meridian, Washington, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by said Heirs of Margaret Thomas:

Now Know Ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have given and Granted and by these presents do Give and Grant unto the said Heirs of Margaret Thomas, and to their heirs, the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Heirs of Margaret Thomas and to their heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided for by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United State.

In Testimony Whereof I, Theodore Roosevelt, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
