The Grantors, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred fifty dollars, in hand paid, convey and warrant to the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the following described real property situated in the county of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit:
