

has located and do hereby locate 1,500 linear feet in length,
and 600 feet in width on the Mann Butte Lode

72269 lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in above State, County or Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery Shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence
400 feet in a northerly
direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 300 feet in a westerly
direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 1,500 feet in a southerly
direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 600 feet in a easterly
direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 1,500 feet in a northerly
