NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the undersigned, having complied with the re-
quirements of Chapter Six, Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States,
and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said district,


has located and does hereby locate 1,500 linear feet in length,
and 600 feet in width on the Mann Butte Lode

lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in above State, County or Mining District, and further describ-
ed as follow:: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery Shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence

direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 300 feet in a Westerly
direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 1,500 feet in a Southerly
direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 600 feet in a Easterly
direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 1,500 feet in a Northerly
direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence 300 feet in a Westerly
