

SAMSON TO BANK OF STEVENSON.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Sam Samson, and Flora Samson, his wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, do by these presents assign, transfer and set-over unto Bank of Stevenson, a Washington corporation, a certain indenture of mortgage made and executed by James Peterson, party of the second part therein, dated October 17th. 1911, and recorded October 18th. 1911 in Book K of Mortgages at page 318, records of Skamania County, Washington, Together with the promissory notes therein described, and the money due and to grow due thereon, with interest.

And the said parties of the first part do hereby make, constitute and appoint the said party of the second part their attorney in fact irrevocable in their name or otherwise, but at the cost of the said second party, to have, use and take all lawful means for the recovery of said money and interest; and in case of payment, to discharge the same as fully as the said parties of the first part might or could if these presents were not made.
