Notice of Location of Mining Claim (QUARTZ)

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, Leon Montchalin of Route 2,
Washougal, Washington

having complied with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and with all the local laws, customs and regulations, has this 10th day of October, 1969, located a claim and by these presents does locate a claim by right of discovery and location, 1500 linear feet horizontal measurement on and along Tuff lode, vein, ledge or deposit, along the vein thereof, with all dips, angles and variations as allowed by law, together with 1500 feet on the North side and 1500 feet on the South side of the middle of said vein at the surface so far as can be determined from present developments, and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground within the lines of said claim, 300 linear feet, running Northerly from this discovery post and 300 feet running Southerly from this discovery post, said discovery post being situated upon said lode, vein or deposit and within the lines of said claim in St. Helens mining district, Skamania County, State of Washington, which claim is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at this discovery post being the center of the vein, and upon which this notice is posted thence 300 feet Northerly to a post marked Northwest corner; thence 1500 feet Northeasterly to a post marked Northeast corner; thence 600 feet Southerly to a post marked center end; thence 300 feet Southerly to a post marked Southeast corner; thence 1500 feet Southerly to a post marked Southwest corner; thence 300 feet Northerly to Discovery center end. being approximately 80 feet Northerly on Platinum Creek from its junction with Quartz Creek and is designated and known as Tuff Claim No. 2

Describe the claim accurately, with reference to some natural object or permanent monument, and if on surveyed land according to government survey, and mark the boundaries on the ground so they may be readily traced.

Lode locations may include fifteen hundred feet on the course of the ledge, together with three hundred feet on each side of the middle of the vein.
