LINES ON CURRENT MAP bears EAST 660 FT. distant

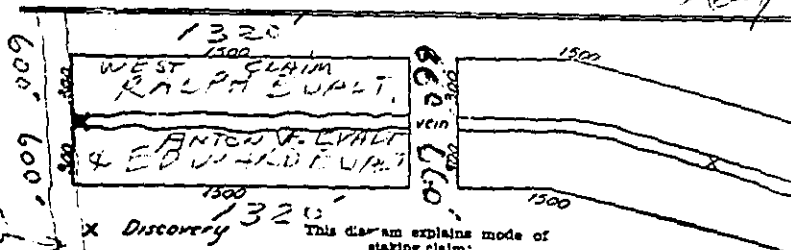
