

Whiteside to Kollock

Know all men by these presents that George S. Whiteside and Adeline C. Whiteside, his wife of Portland County of Multnomah State of Oregon in consideration of Five & 00/100 (\$5.00) Dollars to them paid by W.M. Kollock of Hood River, County of Hood River, State of Oregon, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto said W.M. Kollock his heirs and assigns all the following bounded and described real property situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington: Beginning at an iron pipe at or near the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section nineteen (19) township three (3) North of Range ten (10) east of Willamette Meridian; running thence westerly thirteen and one half (13½) chains more or less to an iron pipe, thence northerly twenty and three fourth chains (20-3/4) chains, more or less to an iron pipe, thence easterly thirteen and one half (13½) chains more or less to an iron pipe; thence southerly twenty and three fourth (20-3/4) chains more or less to place of beginning, save and except a right of way over and across said parcel of land, by a road having a southeasterly direction, or by a road equally as good, which right of way said grantors reserve to themselves, their heirs and assigns. Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and also all estate right title and interest in and to the same including dower and claim of dower.

To Have and to Hold the above described premises unto the said W.M. Kollock his heirs and assigns forever. And George S. Whiteside and Adeline C. Whiteside, the grantors above named do covenant to and with the above named grantee his heirs and assigns that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises and that same are free from all incumbrances, except from said right of way and that they will and their heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the above granted premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever except from said right of way.
