This Indenture Witnesseth that J.F. Sweeney and Mary E. Sweeney his wife of Stevenson, Wash in consideration of eight hundred and twenty dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto Harry Hazard the following described premises to-wit:  
Lots numbered 1 and 16 of Block No. 6 and Lots numbered 1 and 16 of Block numbered 6 in River View Addition to the town of Stevenson according to the plat of said town now on file and of record in the office of the Auditor for Skamania County Wash. Also the following land: All land owned by grantors herein east of Blocks 6 and 7 in said addition above mentioned which lies north of railroad right of way, west of Kanana Creek and south of County Road running along the north side of said Block 7 of said addition, said land being situated in Sec. 36 Tp. 3 N. R. 7 and 7 1/2 east of W.M., except a strip of land 60 feet wide heretofore deeded as an extension of second street of the city of Stevenson. Together with tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Harry Hazard his heirs and assigns forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of eight hundred twenty dollars with interest thereon according to the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy to wit:

\$820.00 Stevenson, Wash Sept. 27th 1912

On or before one year after date for value received we promise to pay to the order of Harry Hazard eight hundred twenty dollars with interest thereon at rate of 10 per cent per annum from date, and if not so paid the whole sum of Both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible at the option of the holder of this note. If the interest is not paid when due it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest therewith, principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States. And in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof we promise to pay such addition as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys fees to be taxed as part of the costs of such suit for the use of
