

## O'Conner to Gray

This Indenture Made this 6th day of June A.D.1906 by and between W.W.O'Conner party of the first part and W.A.Gray, party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of Five Dollars paid to said party of the first part by said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold quitclaimed and released and by these presents do bargain, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said W.A. Gray, his heirs, successors and assigns, all the right title interest claim and demand of said party of the first part of, in and to the following described tracts, lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit:

The following named Mining Claims situated in section six, township 10 north range 5 east of Willamette Meridian, consisting of nine claims, to-wit: Known as the Old Trade Dollar mining claims, one claim commencing at what is known as the Ore Bunkers, and running in a northeasterly direction 1500 linear feet, being 300 feet wide on each side of center line of Vein.

One claim commencing at what is known as the Ore Bunkers and running in a southwesterly direction 1500 linear feet being 300 feet wide on each side of center line of Vein.

Situated in the St. Helens Mining District. Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances whereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the above quitclaimed premises with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever.
