locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, CLAIMS 1,320 FT linear feet and horizontal measurement on the SILVER CLAIM

OF 660 FT lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 330 DUE WEST feet ON EACH side and 330 DUE EAST feet on the EAST FORK OF THE LEWIS RIVER side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,

lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 330 feet running DUE EAST from center of discovery 330 DUE WEST and 1,320 FT feet running DUE SOUTH from center of discovery 1,320 FT; said discovery

IS being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines of said claim, in T4N R5E SECTION 16 SE 1/4 BY SE 1/4 EXTENDING INTO SECTION 21 NE 1/4 Mining District, U.S. PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST

SECTION LOCATED 3 MILES TO ORE CENTERLINE APPROX. FROM SUNSET FALLS, described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: THE ORE VEIN IS ON SOUTH BORDER OF THE EAST FORK OF THE LEWIS RIVER ACROSS RIVER FROM LARGE FIR TREE

BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the EAST OR NE corner), running thence WEST feet 330 DUE, to a post marked CENTERLINE; thence 330' feet WEST, to a post marked WEST CLAIM corner (Cor. No. 2); thence DUE SOUTH feet 1,320', to a post marked SILVER CLAIM corner (Cor. No. 3); thence DUE EAST feet 330', to a post marked CENTERLINE SOUTH; thence 330' feet DUE EAST, to a post marked SE CLAIM corner (Cor. No. 4); thence DUE NORTH feet 1,320 FT to a post marked NE OR EAST corner, the place beginning.

This claim is further described as follows: The point of discovery upon which this notice is posted is in a EASTERLY direction from the center of the SUNSET FALLS line, distant 3 MILES feet. From Cor. No. CENTERLINE OF ORE VEIN WHICH BEARS DUE SOUTH distant 1,320 FT and PARALLELS EXISTING SECTION LINES ON CURRENT MAPS & BEARS ONE TENTH OF A MILE distant WEST OF A SHORT ROAD WHICH GOES DOWN TO THE EAST FORK OF THE LEWIS RIVER & ENDS THERE. THIS SHORT ROAD JUNCTS FROM ROAD #420 WHICH FOLLOWS THE EAST FORK OF THE LEWIS RIVER. THE ORE VEIN IS LOCATED ON SOUTH SIDE OF THE E FORK LEWIS RIVER.

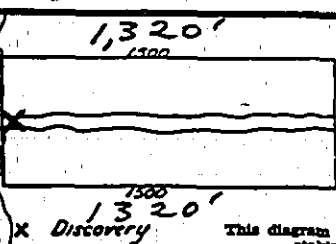

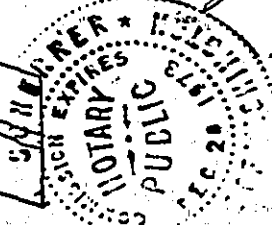
