1,320 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the SILVER

VEIN'S lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,
 angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 1,320 feet ON EACH
 side and 660 feet on the EAST & WEST side of the middle
 of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,
 lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 13 660 feet

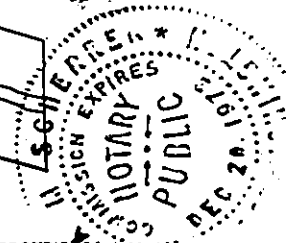
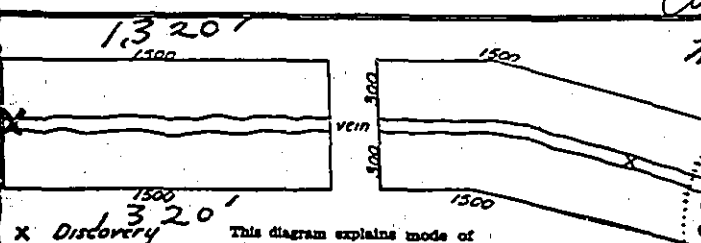
