Goddard to Packard

Whereas on the 27th day of March 1907, Edmund C. Goddard and Minnie M. Goddard, of the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, in consideration of two thousand (2000) Dollars to them in hand paid by P.I. Packard, then of the same residence, sold and conveyed to the said P.I. Packard a certain tract of land in the County of Skamania State of Washington, containing twenty-five (25) acres more or less, as per deed recorded in records of said Skamania County, Book K page 294 in which said conveyance the land was described in haec verbae as follows:

"The North half and the North half of the South half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section twenty-two (22) in Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian, except: A certain tract of land of five acres more or less heretofore conveyed to Kate Cusick. This conveyance is for twenty-five (25) acres more or less, and

Whereas said description is erroneous in part and should have read and was intended to read "The North one half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter and the North one half of the South one half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section twenty-two (22) said Township and Range" in place of the North one half and North one half of the South one half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section, Township and Range, and

Whereas said description is uncertain also as to the five acres more or less in that part of the deed as excepted, to-wit: a certain tract of land of five acres more or less heretofore conveyed to Kate Cusick, and Whereas the said deed recites that said five acres was conveyed to Kate Cusick, when the correct name of the owner of said five acres is Kate Cusic, and

Whereas on the first day of April 1907 the said P.I. Packard and his wife, Lizzie G. Packard executed a certain purchase price mortgage to secure a promissory note in favor of Edmund C. Goddard for the sum of twelve hundred fifty (1250) Dollars, given to secure the balance of the purchase price of the aforesaid land and which said mortgage was duly executed on the first day of April 1907 and was recorded in the registry of Mortgages of Skamania County, Washington, in Book G on page 501 on the 25th day of April 1907, in which said mortgage the description of said land is
