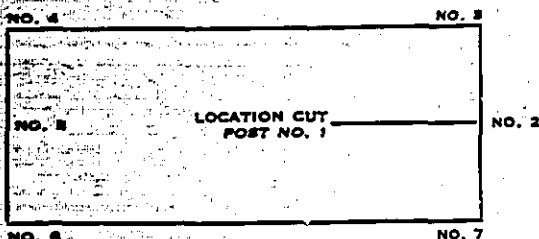

## Notice of Mining Location

feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the WEST end line and 330

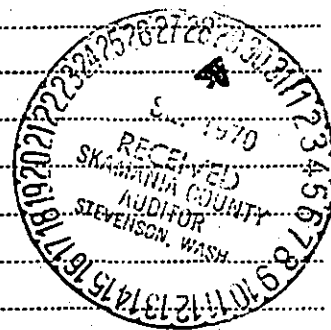
