(x) The Elizabeth Snooks Donation Land Claim, in section 25, township 2 north of range 6 east of Willamette Meridian.

A right of way for one pole or tower line for the transmission of electric current across the following described properties, situated, lying and being in the COUNTY of Skamania, State of Washington.

(a) Sections 32 and 33 in Township 3 north of range 9 east of Willamette Meridian, in United States Forest Reserve.

(b) Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 of section 5, township 1 north of range 6 east of Willamette Meridian.

(c) The south half of the southeast quarter of section 4, township 1 north of range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian.

(d) The northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 9, township 1 north of range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian.

(e) Lots 3 and 4 and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter, and the north half of the northeast quarter of section 35, township 2 north of range 6 east of the Willamette Meridian, excepting 5 acres off the east end, and also excepting any land belonging to Wm. Butler.

(f) Beginning at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of section 6, township 1 north of range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian, thence north along the east line of said quarter section, 16 rods and 10 feet; thence northwesterly along the County Road, 83 rods to point at the junction of Marrin-Vidier Roads with said County Road; thence southwesterly, following said Marrin Road, 36 rods to a point in the south line of section 6 which is 101 rods and 6 feet west of the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of section 6; thence east to said quarter section corner.

All rights of the Northwestern Electric Company granted to it by Ordinance No. 64 of the Town of Camas, in Clarke County, State of Washington, said Ordinance having been read the third time and passed by the Council of said Town of Camas on the 14th day of March, 1911, and approved by the Mayor, and entitled:

"An Ordinance granting to the Northwestern Electric Company, its successors and assigns, for a period of fifty (50) years, the right and privilege to erect, construct, maintain and operate an electric light, heat and power system in the Town of Camas, Clarke County, Washington, and the right and privilege to erect poles, stretch wires thereon and thereover, through, over, under, and upon the streets, alleys, public places and highways, and to construct underground tunnels, conduits or pipes with all necessary entrances, man-holes and other appliances in and under said streets, alleys and public highways in the Town of Camas, for the conducting and conveying of electricity for light, heat and power; to charge rent and tolls therefor, and to collect the same."

All rights of the Northwestern Electric Company granted to it by Ordinance No. 20 of the Town of Washougal, in Clarke County, State of Washington, passed by the Council on November 20, 1911, and approved by the Mayor November 20, 1911, entitled:

"An ordinance granting to the Northwestern Electric Company, its successors and assigns, for a period of fifty (50) years, the right and privilege to erect, construct, maintain and operate an electric light, heat and power system in the Town of Washougal, Clarke County, Washington, and the right and privilege to erect poles, stretch wire thereon
