and thereover, through, over, under and upon the streets, alleys, public places and highways and to construct underground tunnels, conduits or pipes, with all necessary entrances, man-holes and other appliances in and under said streets, alleys and public highways in the Town of Washougal, for the conducting and conveying of electricity for lights, heat and power; to charge rents and tolls therefor, and to collect the same."

All rights of the Northwestern Electric Company under a certain franchise granted to said company by the County of Skamania, State of Washington, whereby said company is authorized to erect pole and tower lines along certain of the county roads of said county, for a period of fifty (50) years, said franchise having been granted by the County Commissioners of Skamania County on the 4th day of January, 1912. The rights of way granted in said franchise are more specifically described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the west boundary line of Skamania County, thence along the old Military Road known as the Vancouver & Cascades Road to the intersection with the Mount Pleasant Road; thence along said road to its intersection with the Vancouver and Cascades Road to the western boundary of the Town of Stevenson; beginning at the eastern boundary of the Town of Stevenson, thence along the Vancouver & Cascades Road to the intersection with the Carson & Ash Road; thence along said road to its intersection with the St.Martin's Hill Road; thence along said road to its intersection with the Rock Creek and Collins Road; thence along said road to the Village of Collins;

Beginning at the Village of Cooks along the Cooks Landing and Mill A Road to its intersection with the Cooks and Drano Hill Road; thence along said road to its intersection with the Drano Hill Road; thence along said road to its intersection with the Underwood and Chenowith Road; thence along said road with its intersection with the Underwood White Salmon Road; also along Buck Creek Road beginning at its intersection with the Underwood and Chenowith Road.

All rights of Northwestern Electric Company under a certain franchise granted to said company by the County of Clarke, State of Washington, whereby said company is authorized to construct and maintain electric light lines, electric tower lines and pole lines along certain of the roads and streets in Clarke County, Washington, for a period of fifty (50) years, said franchise having been granted by the County Commissioners of Clarke County, Washington, on the 3rd day of January, 1912, and the rights of way granted in said franchise being more specifically described as follows, towit:

Beginning at the east boundary of the town of Washougal, Washington, and running thence east along the Washougal-Mount Pleanant Road to the east boundary of Clarke County. Also beginning at the west boundary of Washougal, where the same intersects the Washougal - Perkersville Road, running thence westerly along said road to the west end of Orchards Avenue in Oak Park Addition, thence westerly across the Washougal River to intersect with the County Road leading to Camas, thence along said road to the city boundary of said City of Camas.

And also all improvements, extensions or additions made or at any time hereafter to be made to any and all of said plants or property, real or personal, and all
replacements or renewals of the same or of any part thereof.

TOGETHER WITH ALL AND singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion, remainders, income, rents, issues and profits thereof.
