

## IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON FOR THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA.

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Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard regularly before the Court, and it appearing to the Court that, as per stipulation of the parties, this cause has been heretofore heard before the Court, and the Court has determined the damages to be paid to the claimants, Columbia Valley Railroad Company, Louis Gerlinger and Sophia Gerlinger, at the sum of One and to the claimant Oregon Lumber Company Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, for the taking and injuriously affecting the lands and premises sought to be appropriated by this proceeding, irrespective of any benefits to be derived from the proposed improvement, and that the Court has made an order of condemnation in the premises;

And it further appearing to the Court that the petitioner has paid to the said Columbia Valley Railroad Company and Louis Gerlinger and Sophia Gerlinger the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and to the Oregon Lumber Company the said sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars being in the amounts awarded as aforesaid, and that the petitioner has also paid the costs of this action, including the costs of the claimants;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the land and premises described in the petition herein, to wit: All that part of section twenty-seven (27), and lots three (3) and four (4), of section thirty-four (34), all in township three (3), north of range nine (9), east of the Willamette Meridian, lying within lines parallel to and distant one hundred fifty (150) feet on the north side, and one hundred fifty (150) feet on the south side of the center line of the railway of the petitioner, as same is surveyed, staked out, and located over, across and upon said lots three (3) and four (4), in said section thirty-four (34), township and range aforesaid, which are the lands and premises sought to be condemned and appropriated by the petitioner for the purposes of its incorporation, be and the same are hereby condemned and appropriated by the petitioner, and the claimants be and they are hereby divested of all right, title and interest in and to the same.
