Know All Men by These Presents That W K Beach

the undersigned citizen of the United States, has this 28th day of October 1969, located and claimed, and by these presents does locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations,

1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the Jenny No 3 lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 300 feet North-Easterly side and 300 feet on the South-Westerly side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 10 feet running North-West from center of discovery Post, and 1490 feet running South-East from center of discovery Post; said discovery Post being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines of said claim, in Silver Star Mining District, Skamania County SE 1/4 Sec 33, T4N, R5E, W1W described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the NW corner), running thence 1500 feet S 60° E, to a post marked No 2; thence 600 feet S 30° W, to a post marked No 3 corner (Cor. No. 2); thence 1500 feet N 30° W, to a post marked No 4 corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 600 feet N 30° E, to a post marked No 1; thence 600 feet S 30° E, to a post marked No 1 corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 600 feet S 30° E, to a post marked No 1 corner, the place beginning.

This claim is further described as follows: The point of discovery upon which this notice is posted is in a South-Easterly direction from the center of the North-Westerly line, distant 10 feet. From Cor. No. 1, NW Cor SEC 33 bears N 33° W distant 474.5 FT and SW Cor SEC 33 bears S 55 1/2° W, 298.5 FT distant
