E. Michell and Jane A. Michell of Seaview, Wash. the following-described premises to wit: Lot Twenty-five (25) in block Six (6) in the Town of Stevenson in Skamania County, Washington, according to the official plat thereof now on file in the office of the Auditor of aforesaid County and State.

Together with tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the same, with the appurtenances, unto the said P. E. Michell and Jane A. Michell of Seaview Wash. their heirs and assigns Forever.

THIS CONVEYANCE is intended as a mortgage, to secure the payment of the sum of One-hundred-eighty-seven and 50/100 (187.50) dollars, and the interest thereon, in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note, of which the following is a copy, to-wit:

One year after date, for value received we promise to pay to the order of P. E. Michell and Jane A. Michell the sum of One-hundred-eighty-seven and 50/100 dollars with interest thereon payable Semiannually at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from date: and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectable at the option of the holder of this note. If interest is not paid when due it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest therewith, principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States. and in case suit is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof, we promise to pay such additional sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees, to be taxed as a part of costs of such suit, for the use of plaintiff's attorney.
