Richardson of Multnomah County State of Oregon do hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said J. J. Richardson and unto his heirs and assigns, all their right, title and interest in and to all that parcel of real estate situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit: All that part of the North side of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section six (6) in Township three (3) North of Range eight (8) East of Willamette Meridian that lies north of a line running east between the north and the south half of the Northeast quarter Sec. One (1) Township three (3) North of Range seven and one half (7½) East of the Willamette Meridian. This deed is given to correct the description in a former deed given by Cyrus C. Wetherell and wife to Richard E. Haworth and dated November 23rd 1901, recorded March 28th 1904 in Book H on page 594. To have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said J. J. Richardson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

## United States to Williams

The United States of America, to all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a schedule of allotments approved by the Secretary of the Interior July 30, 1908, whereby it appears that Georgia Williams, an Indian of the Cowlitz tribe or band, has been allotted the following described land: The Lot four and the southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section four in Township three North of Range ten East of the Willamette Meridian, Washington, containing seventy-nine and thirty-hundredths acres

Now Know Ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, has allotted, and by these presents does allot unto the said Georgia Williams the land above described and hereby declares that it does and will hold the land thus allotted (subject to all statutory provisions
