

LOCATION NOTICE

Know All Men by These Presents That Galvin Lord and A.R. Grantthe undersigned citizen S of the United States, ha VE this 17th day ofOctober 1970, located and claimed, and by these presents do
locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress,
approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations,1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on theChristie # 13 lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,
angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 300 feet Nside and 300 feet on the S side of the middle
of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 1450 feetrunning E from center of discovery post, and 50feet running W from center of discovery post; said discoverypost being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the linesof said claim, in McCoy Creek Mining District, Sec 10, T10N, R8E, W1HSkamania County described by metes and
bounds as follows, to-wit:

feet W, to a post marked 4 corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 600
feet N, to a post marked 1; thence 1500 feet
to a post marked 1 corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 600 feet
to a post marked 2 corner, the place beginning.
