The Grantors, George S. Whiteside and Adeline C. Whiteside, his wife, of the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand (\$2000 .00) Dollars in hand paid, convey and warrant to Hugh W. Hamlin, a married man, the following described real estate, to-wit:

The undivided one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of that parcel of land beginning at the Northwest corner of Section nineteen (19) in Township three North of Range ten East of W.M., and running thence East along the North line of said Section to a point which is the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section, from thence south along the east line of said quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) section to a point which is one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the distance to the middle post of said section nineteen (19) (this point marks the northeast corner of a parcel of land deeded to Corlie and the northwest corner of land belonging to Kellock.)
