

LOCATION NOTICE

Know All Men by These Presents That Galua Lord and A. R. Grant

the undersigned citizen S of the United States, ha VE this 18th day of October 1970, located and claimed, and by these presents do locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, 1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the Christie #19 lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 300 feet N side and 300 feet on the S side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 1450 feet running E from center of discovery post, and 50 feet running W from center of discovery post; said discovery post being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines of said claim, in McCoy Creek Mining District, SE 15 T10N, R8E W1M Skamania County described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the NW corner), running thence 1500 feet E, to a post marked 2; thence 600 feet S, to a post marked 3 corner (Cor. No. 2); thence 1500 feet W, to a post marked 4 corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 600 feet N, to a post marked 1; thence 1500 feet E, to a post marked 5 corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 600 feet S, to a post marked 6 corner, the place beginning.

This claim is further described as follows: The point of discovery upon which this notice is posted is in a W direction from the center of the W end line, distant 50 feet. From Cor. No. #1, Intersection McCoy-Camp Creeks bears N 29 W distant 6750' and W distant 1500'
