

Thurston to Moore

This Indenture made this 5th day of April 1909 between Mary Thurston and Wm. Thurston her husband, the parties of the first part and Chas D. Moore & Arvilla Moore his wife, parties of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of \$2500.00) Twenty five hundred dollars in gold coin of the United States to us in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, the following described tract 20 acre lot or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, bounded and described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the West half of the Northeast quarter of section twenty in Township 3 North of Range eight East of W.M., running thence South 80 rods, thence West 40 rods, thence North eighty rods, thence East 40 rods to place of beginning, containing 20 acres. Together with the appurtenances to have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever.
