CONDIT TO HENRY M. THOMPSON.

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, That B.C. Condit, For value received hereby releases the land hereinafter described, from that certain mortgage made and executed by HENRY M. THOMPSON, to A.Y. MARSH, on the 22 day of June, 1911, and recorded on the 26th day of June, 1911, in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, in book K of Mortgages at page 220, which mortgage was executed to secure the payment of two (2) promissory notes of Three Thousand Four Hundred (\$3,400) each, and covered the following described real estate and water rights in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:
