

## Luscher to Haffey

Know all men by these presents that we, Frederick Luscher & Anna B. Luscher, husband and wife, of Bridal Veil, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, in consideration of two hundred dollars to us paid by Bernard A. Haffey of Cape Horn, County of Skamania, State of Washington, do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said Bernard A. Haffey and unto his heirs and assigns, all the right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate situate in Cape Horn, County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

Commencing at the northwest corner of the real estate of the estate of William Haffey, deceased, running thence south along the west line of said real estate of said estate eighty four (84) rods and sixteen (16) links to the northwest corner of that portion of real estate set off or apportioned out of the said estate of James Haffey, thence east along the north line of that portion of real estate set off or apportioned out of the said estate as aforesaid to the west line of that portion of real estate set off or apportioned out of said estate to Frank Haffey, thence north along said line of said real estate so set apart or apportioned to said Frank Haffey to the north line of said estate, thence west along said north line of said estate to the place of beginning, said described real estate containing 17 and 1/5 acres more or less and being a portion of the real estate of said estate, situated in Skamania County Washington.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to the said Bernard A. Haffey and to his heirs and assigns forever.
