This Indenture Made this 15 day of May A.D. 1908 between Catherine Teets (married) of Multnomah County State of Oregon, of the first part, and Hugh M. Teets of Multnomah County State of Oregon, of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to her duly paid, has sold and by these presents does grant and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington and described as follows:

Lots five (5) and six (6) and the North half of the Southeast quarter of Section eight (8) all in Township three (3) North of Range six (6) East W.M., containing one hundred and sixty-four and 26/100 acres, more or less, together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, with all the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of said party of the first part therein.
