the owner of said mining claim in the sum and value of more than One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200) Dollars

Discovery shafts were cleaned out and deepened by utilizing dynamite to excavate additional bedrock from the bottoms of such shafts. At least 250 man hours of labor were expended on this work and on removing brush from the claim lines. Claim corners and other boundary markers were repainted and relabeled where necessary.
