approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, CLAIM'S

1,800 FT linear feet and horizontal measurement on the TUNGSTEN SILVER

COBALT & NICKEL ETC lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,

angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 1500 feet SEON EACH

side and 900 feet on the EAST & WEST side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,

lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 1800 feet

running DUE SOUTH from center of discovery 1500 FT, and 900 FT

feet running EAST from center of discovery 900 FT; said discovery

No. 2); thence 900 FT feet DUE EAST, to a post marked S.EAST corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 1500 feet DUE NORTH, to a post marked NORTH EAST CORNER; thence 900 feet DUE WEST, to a post marked CENTERLINE corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 900 feet DUE WEST, to a post marked N.WEST corner, the place beginning THE CENTERLINE OF THIS THREE CLAIM NOTICE IS THE BORDER OF C-4 & C-9




