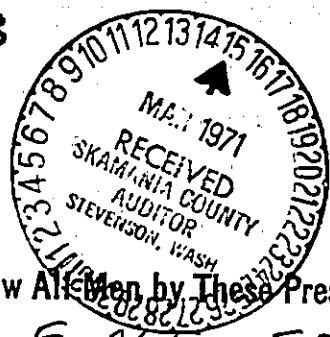




LOCATION NOTICE

Know All Men by These Presents That ANTON V. EUALT & EDWARD V. EUALT OF 8603 NE 107TH AVE. VANCOUVER, WASH. CLAIMS THREE CLAIMS ON THIS NOTICE.

the undersigned citizen S of the United States, have this 8TH day of MARCH 1971, located and claimed, and by these presents do ES locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress,

approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, CLAIMS 1,500 BY 1,800 linear, feet and horizontal measurement on the TUNGSTEN SILVER & ALL ASSOCIATED ORE'S lodes, vein, ledge or deposit, along the vein thereof, with all its dips,

angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 900 feet ON EACH ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FT side and 1500 feet on the NORTH TO SOUTH side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,

lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 1500 feet running DUE SOUTH from center of discovery CENTERLINE OF RIVER, and 900 feet running DUE EAST from center of discovery SILVER & TUNGSTEN; said discovery

is being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines of said claim, in T4N-R5E SECTION #19 NE 1/4 BY SE 40 PLUS THREE 40 ACRE PLOTS, Mining District, PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST THREE THIS CLAIM PLOT USES THE CENTERLINE OF THE EAST FORK OF THE LEWIS RIVER described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: AS ITS NORTH BORDER.

BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the N.E. NORTH EAST corner), running thence 1500 feet DUE SOUTH, to a post marked S.E. CORNER; thence 900 FT feet DUE WEST, to a post marked CENTERLINE corner (Cor. No. 2); thence 900 FT feet DUE WEST, to a post marked SW corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 1500 feet DUE NORTH, to a post marked NORTH WEST COR; thence 900 feet DUE EAST, to a post marked CENTER corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 900 feet DUE EAST to a post marked NORTH EAST corner, the place beginning.

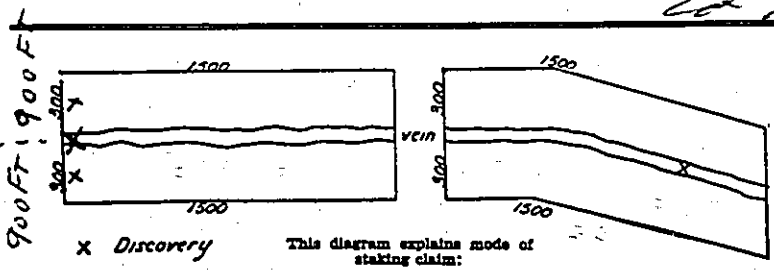
