

located and claimed, and by these presents do ES locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, CLAIMS

600 BY 1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the SILVER TUNGSTEN & GOLD ANTIMONY & ALL ASSOCIATED ORES OF SILVER lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,

angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 300 feet ON EACH

side and 1500 feet on the NORTH & TO SOUTH side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,

lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim is 300 feet

running DUE EAST & DUE WEST from center of discovery 300 FT., and 1500

feet running DUE NORTH from center of discovery & DUE SOUTH; said discovery

is being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines

of said claim, in R 5 E T 4 N SECTION 17 SW 1/4 BY SW 1/4 APPROX THIS Mining District,

CLAIM CENTERLINE IS ALIGNED DUE NORTH WITH GUMBOOT described by metes and

bounds as follows, to-wit: MOUNTAIN ROAD INTERSECTION WITH EAST FORK OF THE LEWIS RIVER ROAD # 420

BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the SOUTH WEST corner), running thence DUE EAST feet 300 FEET, to a post marked CENTERLINE; thence 300 feet DUE EAST, to a post marked SOUTHEAST corner (Cor. No. 2); thence 1500 feet DUE NORTH, to a post marked NE COR. corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 300 feet DUE WEST, to a post marked CENTERLINE; thence 300 feet DUE WEST, to a post marked NW corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 1500 feet DUE SOUTH to a post marked SOUTH WEST corner, the place beginning.


