## Notice of Mining Location

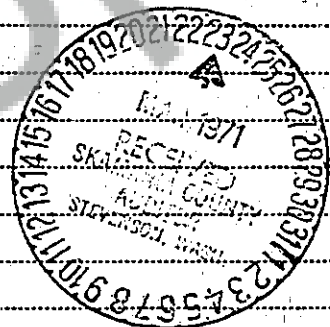

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-Two, of the revised statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District ha..... located and do..... hereby locate 1600 linear feet in length, and 600 feet in width on the Eagle Creek (Name of) Place vein, ledge or deposit situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence.....  
 From Post No. 1 300 feet in a Easterly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence  
900 feet in a Northerly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence  
1500 feet in a Westerly direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence  
300 feet in a Southerly direction to an end post marked No. 5, thence  
300 feet in a Southerly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence  
1500 feet in a Easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 7, thence  
300 feet in a Northerly direction to said end post marked No. 2; hereby  
 locating and intending to claim 1500 feet in a Westerly

direction from discovery to the 1500 end line and 1500  
 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the Easterly end line and 300  
 feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.
