Thence 300' N Westerly 50° direction to N.E. corner of Little Trinkle #2, and adjoining S border of Silver Road Claims.

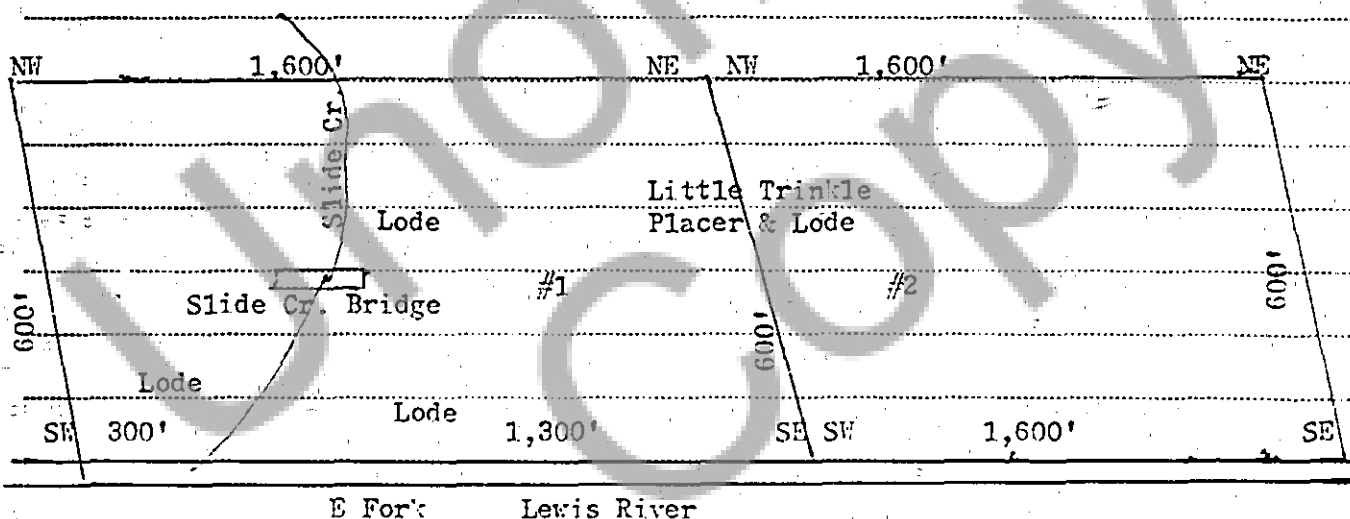
Thence 1,600' in a N Westerly direction to N.W. corner of Little Trinkle #1.
