Nissen to Bank of Stevenson

This Indenture Made this 31st day of July 1909 between William Nissen and Lucele Nissen his wife parties of the first part and Bank of Stevenson, a Washington corproation, party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the frist part for and in consideration of the sim of four hundred and no/100 dollars (\$400.00) lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowedged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second apart its successors and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

Lot number fifteen (15) in Block number One (1) of the Town of Stevenson, according to the official plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County Washington. Together with all and singular the tenemtns hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of Four hundred dollars lawful money of the United States, together ith interest thereon at the rate of ten per cent per annum from date until paid according to the terms and conditio s of one certain promissory note bearing date July 31st 1909 made by William Nissen and Lucele Nissen payable one year after date to the order of Bank of Stevenson, and these presents shall be void if such payment be made according to the terms and conditions thereof. But in case default be made in the payment of the principal or interest of said promissory note or any part thereof, when the same shall be due and payable according to the terms and conditions thereof, then the said party of the second part, its successors or assigns may immediately thereafter in the manner provided by law, foreclose this mortgage for the whole sum due upon said principal and interest with all the other sums hereby secured. In any suit or other proceedings which may be had for the recovery of the amount due on e ther this note of this mortgage, said party of the second part its successors or assigns shall have the right to include in the judgment which may be recovered the sum as the court shall adjudge reasonable as attorneyss fees to be taxed as part of the costs in such suit as well as all payments which said party of the second part may be obliged to make for its or their security by insurance or on account of any taxes, charges incumbrances or assessments whatsoever on the said premises or any part thereof. In case of foreclosure of this mortgage the party of the second part its successors or assigns shall be entitled to have entered in such foreclosure suit a judgment for any deficiency remaining due upon account of the indebtednes secured thereby including taxes, insurance or other lawful assessments after applying the proceeds of the sale of the premises above described to the payment thereof and to the costs of such foreclosure suit.
