The center line of the proposed channel of Woodard Creek is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point eleven hundred ninety-six (1196) feet west and three hundred eighty-five (385) feet south of the corner to sections twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26), thirty-five (35) and thirty-six (36), township two (2) north, range six (6) east of the Willamette meridian; thence in a northwesterly direction on a course north seventy-eight degrees (78°) fifty-one minutes (51') west a distance of three hundred forty-two (342) feet; thence on a curve to the right having a radius of seven hundred sixteen and eight-tenths (716.8) feet a distance of four hundred seventy-one and nine-tenths (471.9) feet; thence on tangent to said curve on a course north forty-one degrees (41°) six minutes (06') west, a distance of four hundred eighty-six and one-tenth (486.1) feet, situated in the county of Skamania and state of Washington.

The grantor reserves the right to cross the premises herein granted with flumes, tramways and logging roads, plans of the same to be subject to the approval of the chief engineer of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company; this reservation to continue for a period of twenty (20) years from the date hereof.
