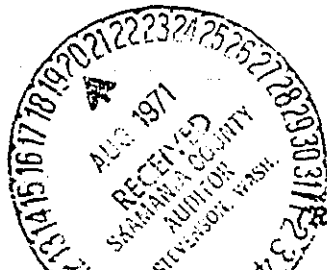
the owner _____ of said mining claim in the sum and value of more than Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) _____ Dollars

that such labor and improvements consisted of XXXXXXXXXX ~~XXXXXX~~ discovery shafts were cleaned out and deepened by utilizing dynamite to excavate additional bedrock from the bottoms of such shafts and a rock sample from each shaft was taken. Claim corners and other boundary markers were repainted and relabeled where necessary. Compass tape survey was conducted to establish actual location of claim corners. At least 400 man hours of labor were expended on this work.

The assessment work was done between May 8 and June 26, 1971 and extended over Thirty (30) days' time, and that the same was filed by said William J. Schwerin, agent BEAR CREEK MINING COMPANY
