DUE EAST to a post marked SE corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 1500 feet
DUE NORTH to a post marked NE COR #18 corner, the place beginning.

This claim is further described as follows: The point of discovery upon which this notice is posted is in a EASTERLY direction from the center of the SUNSET end
 line, distant 1800 feet. From Cor. No. 2 NW COR FALLS
 bears CORNER distant STARTS and AT THE NE CORNER OF
EVALT #11 AND bears EAST OF EVALT #11 distant

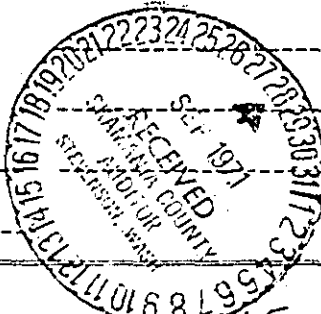

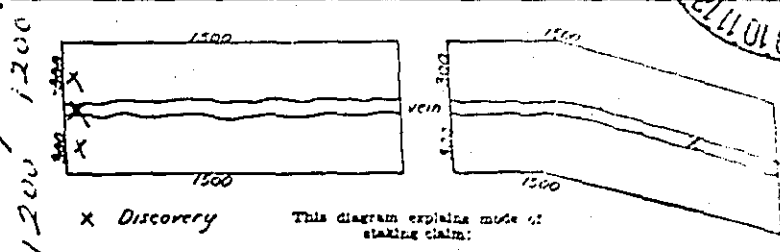
