



Notice of Mining Location

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-Two, of the revised statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District has..... located and does..... hereby locate 3,000' linear feet in length, and 600' feet in width on the Little Trinkle #1 & #2 lode, (Name of) vein, ledge or deposit situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence.....

200' feet in a Southerly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence
 2,800' feet in a Easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence
 600' feet in a N Westerly 50° direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence
 1,500' feet in a Westerly direction to an end post marked No. 5, thence
 1,500' feet in a Westerly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence
 600' feet in a S Easterly 50° direction to a corner post marked No. 7, thence
 200' feet in a Easterly direction to said end post marked No. 2; hereby
 locating and intending to claim 2,800' feet in a Easterly
 direction from discovery to the East end line and 200'
 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the West end line and 300'

feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as follows (and state distance from natural object or permanent monument, Section, Township and Range, if possible):

Sec. 17 T4N R5E WM: Amendment to Little Trinkle Placer & Lode Claims #1 & #2 as recorded in Amendment #73299 in Book L, Page 451 on the 1st day of April, 1971. This amendment will shorten Little Trinkle #1 by 100' & Little Trinkle #2 by 106' to standardize dimensions. Little Trinkle #1 & #2, with a combined length of 3,000' and a width of 600'

The adjoining claims are Half-Penny Placer & Lode Claim on the West, Center of the E. Fork of Lewis River on the South, Lucky Streak on the East, and Silver Road Group on the North

This notice is placed at discovery on post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner and both center ends, and the name of this lode and date of location are placed on all posts.
