

NOTICE OF LOCATION
LODE MINING CLAIM

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This mining claim, the name of which is the GLO 4, was located by the undersigned on the 14th day of September, 1972. Said claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide, 300 feet on each side of the centerline of said claim, the course of which is from northwest to southeast. A NOTICE OF LOCATION is posted on the centerline 50 feet from the north end and 1450 feet from the south end. This claim is located in the Green River (St. Helen's) Mining District, in Skamania County, State of Washington, about 1560 feet in a S42°W direction from the northeast corner of Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 6 East, W.M. and is located on the northern slope of Goat Mountain.

This claim is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north end line being north, 50 feet from where the location notice is posted; thence west, 300 feet to the northwest corner, a blazed tree; thence southeast, 1500 feet to the southwest corner, a blazed tree; thence east, 600 feet to the southeast corner, a blazed tree; thence northwest, 1500 feet to the northeast corner, a blazed tree; thence west, 300 feet to the point of beginning.

This claim is bounded on the north end by the GLO 3 and on the south end by Ann 29 and Ann 30 mining claims.
