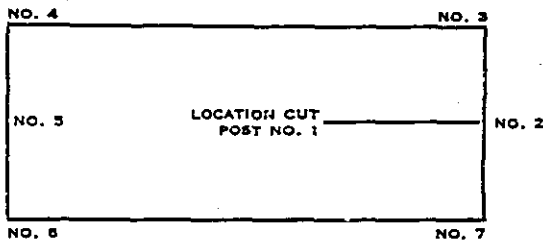

Notice of Mining Location

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-Two, of the revised statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District have located and do hereby locate 1,500 linear feet in length, and 600 feet in width on the Big Buck Mine lode, (Name of) vein, ledge or deposit situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence

300 feet in a Southeasterly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence  
750 feet in a 60°Northeasterly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence  
600 feet in a Northwesterly direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence  
750 feet in a 60°Southeasterly direction to an end post marked No. 5, thence  
750 feet in a 60°Southeasterly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence  
600 feet in a Southeasterly direction to a corner post marked No. 7, thence  
750 feet in a 60°Northeasterly direction to said end post marked No. 2; hereby  
 locating and intending to claim 300 feet in a Northeasterly  
 direction from discovery to the 45 end line and 300  
 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the 12 end line and 750

feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as follows (and state distance from natural object or permanent monument, Section, Township and Range, if possible):

Sec. 6 & 7 T4N R6E Point of discovery is 9,240' in a Northwesterly direction from  
junction of N413 & N413C
