TO: THE WASHINGTON LAND OFFICE, BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT OF THE
U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, Spokane, Washington:

The Primary Gold Company, Inc., a Washington corporation, the owner and claimant of the mining claims described hereafter, does hereby petition for a one (1) year deferment of assessment work on said claims under the authority of the Laws of the United States, 63 Stat. 214; 30 U.S.C. Supp. 28B-E, on the grounds that the employees of Primary Gold Company, Inc., went to the mine site and found it occupied by three individuals who, with the aid of firearms, refused said employees entrance upon the property. Rather than provoke an incident, the employees of Primary Gold Company and its officers determined that this petition should be filed and that a determination of rights to the claims should be made through the courts. For this reason, it is impossible for Primary Gold Company to do their assessment work, although the company does desire to continue to hold said claims.
