## PETITION FOR DEFERMENT OF ASSESSMENT WORK

The Primary Gold Company, Inc., a Washington corporation, the owner and claimant of the mining claims described hereafter, does hereby petition for a one (1) year deferment of assessment work on said claims under the authority of the Laws of the United States, 63 Stat. 214; 30 U.S.C.
