in Skamania County, State of Washington and described and marked on the ground as follows, to-wit:

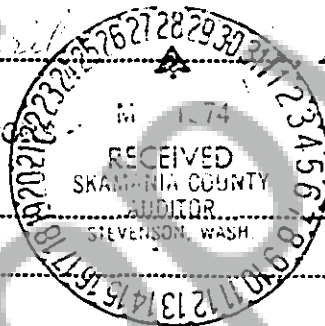
