NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the undersigned, having complied with Section 2234 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local Laws, Customs and Regulations of this

McCoy Mining District, Ha.S. located Fifteen Hundred Feet in length by Six Hundred Feet in width on this the CAMP 22 Lode, Vein or Deposit, bearing Gold, Silver or other precious metals; situated in T20N R8E just east of the junction of McCoy Creek and Camp Creek. 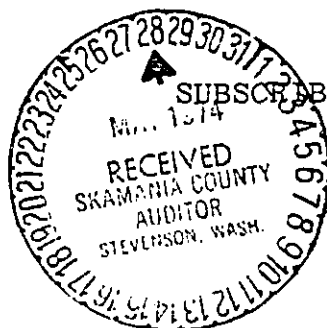
