NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six, Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said district,

has located and does hereby locate 1,500 linear feet in length, and 600 feet in width on the Black Jack

lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in above State, County or Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery Shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence

100 feet in a South

direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 300 feet in a West

direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 1,500 feet in a North

direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 600 feet in a East

direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 1,500 feet in a North

direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence 300 feet in a West

direction to said end post No. 2; hereby locating and intending to claim 100

feet in a South direction from discovery to the South

end line, and 1,400 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the
