FINDER'S FEE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS TONY J. JOLLEY of Boise, Idaho, the Party of the first part owns interest in a certain mining claim of the Wind River Mining Claims of the Paradise Mining district, Skamania County, Washington, and

whereas kenneth H. Peterson, the party of the second part, of Lake (swego, Oregon, having knowledge of certain and undiscovered silver ore body located on the said Wind River Mining Claim, is willing to disclose said ore body and to aid in its recovery for a finders fee, it is

THEREFORE MUTUALLY UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED among the parties hereto as follows:

- l. That the party of the second part shall reveal in detail to the party of the first part, or his duly appointed representative, the location of said ore body by staking and marking the length and width of said location by appropriate markers. The dimensions of said ore body are as follows:

 length : feet 3000 : width 450 : depth 2000 . He shall also perform any other services or duties as requested by the party of the first part in order to aid in the ascertaining of said ore body.
- 2. That the party of the first part agrees to pay a finders fee equal to two per cent (2%) of the total gross value of all silver ore mined from said body of ore as set out in paragraph 1 above, until such time as it is depleted.
- 3. It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part will pay all smeltering and shipping costs on his share as set out herein.
- 4. It is hereby igreed that the party of the first part shall within a reasonable time hereafter commence mining
