Lode Claim on Public Domain

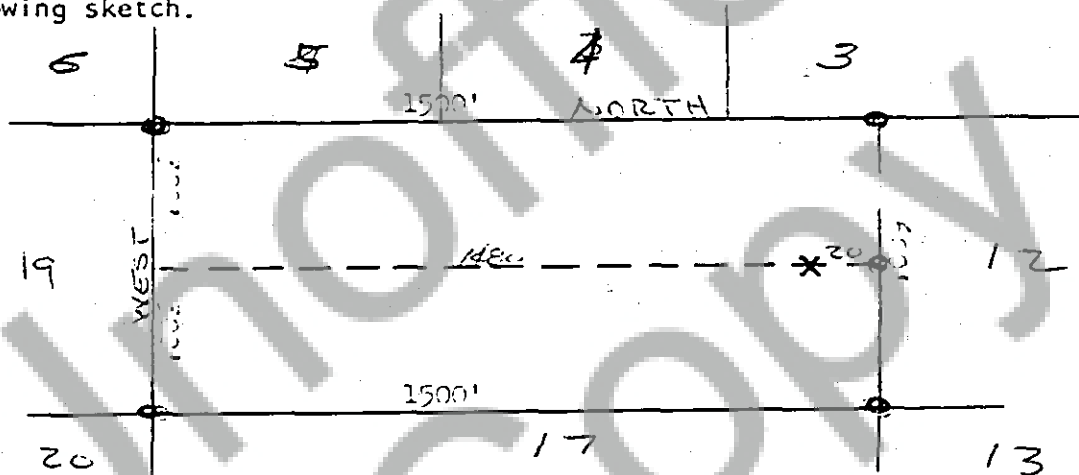
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

All corners are marked by BLAZED TREES & METAL TAGS as shown on the following sketch.



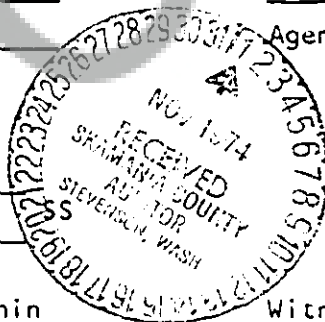
