## Notice of Mining Location

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District, has relocated and does

hereby locate 1500 linear feet in length, and 600 feet in width on the

Quartz Hole #1 (Known as "The Darlena I") lode vein ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel),

from thence 300 feet in a 45° direction to an end post marked

No. 2, thence 1500 feet in a 132° direction to a corner post marked

No. 3, thence 600 feet in a 225° direction to a corner post marked

No. 4, thence 1500 feet in a 310° direction to a corner post marked

No. 5, thence 300 feet in a 45° direction to a corner post marked

to point of origin

No. 6, thence feet in a direction to said end post No. 2;

hereby locating and intending to claim 1500 feet in a N. E.

direction from discovery to the S. E. end line.

and 1500 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the S. W.

end line and 300 feet on each side of the middle of said lode

or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all surface rights, privileges, and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is further described as follows:

It is located in the Northeast corner, Section 21, Township 10N, Range 6E, approximately 200 yards from Forest Service spur entering Unit #3 of Upper Green River Sale, further located as accessible by U. S. F. S. road #115 and located 200 yards south of entrance of spur entering Unit #3 of above unit.

This notice is placed at Discovery on post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner, and the name of this lode, and date of location, are placed on all posts.
